Understanding

The Muslim Educational Trust Dr. Riyaz Ahmed Scholarship Fund awards several scholarships to the students who best exemplify scholastic leadership and who demonstrate active participation in the American Muslim community. Consideration is given to the type of volunteer activity as well as the amount of commitment demonstrated in terms of time and self-sacrifice. To be eligible, the applicants or their parent(s) must be a member of at least one of the community organizations on the front side of this form since October 15, 2007. Recipients of this scholarship are expected to participate in community services and activities during their studies while receiving this scholarship. Activities include and are not limited to volunteering at the community Islamic weekend school, hospitals, elderly care centers, interfaith seminars and lectures, teacher's aid at the MET full-time Islamic school or any local public schools, tutoring students, assisting new immigrants in ESOL, etc. International students are not eligible. If no acceptable applicant applies, the scholarship will not be awarded. Preference will be given to candidates wishing to pursue a career in Law, Journalism, Psychology, Counseling, or Social Work.
