Tarbiyah Reward Distribution System:

- A teacher, administrator, or staff member will give healthy habits raffle tickets to students practicing a “Tarbiyah skill.”
- Raffle tickets will be color coded according to grade level. Orange 1st, Red 2nd, Blue 3rd, purple 4th, Green 5th. Office and Counselor will give White raffle tickets
- Tickets will be distributed by the office for each grade. Please notify the office when your supply is low.
- Raffle tickets will be given to students who exhibit behaviors that are specific to the skills and theme of the month. Other skills exhibited to be awarded as continuation of practicing skills taught in previous months as well, but with a special focus on the current theme and skills.
- The student will put his/her raffle tickets in the Tarbiyah ballot box.
- A drawing will take place at the end of every month, during morning Circle First Friday of the following Month. Ten drawings per month.
- The winning students will be rewarded with gifts from the Tarbiyah prizes box.
- Homeroom teachers will set-up a class time for ‘journaling.’ Students should be able to answer questions such as:
What new skill did you learn today? What surprises you the most about the new skill? How would you apply it in your daily life?
- Two Best journaling work (chosen by the home room teacher) will be announced after Jumu’ah prayer the first Friday of the following month. Winning students will read their reflections in front of ISMET students and will be awarded certificates personalized with their name, month and the Tarbiyah Theme. Group picture will be taken and displayed on the Tarbiyah bulletin board.

The School Counselor will initiate Tarbiyah discussions ȳ once a week during the Morning Circle with the ISMET students. The School Counselor will initiate Tarbiyah discussions every Monday and Friday during the Morning Circle with the OLA students.

Tarbiyah bulletin boards will be organized every month targeting the theme of the month.
